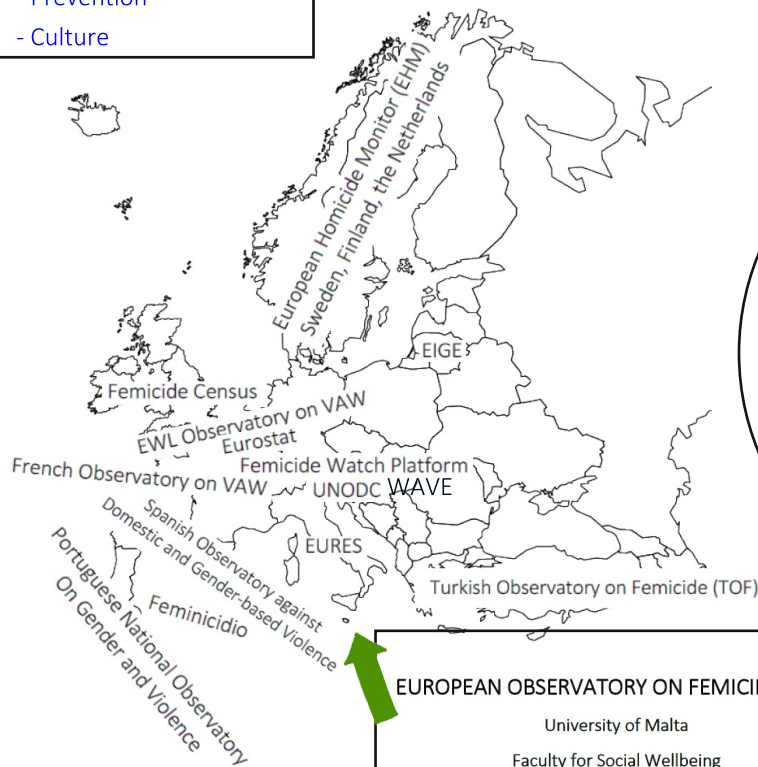

DATA ON FEMICIDE NEEDED

In-depth research that targets the experiences of women ~ Killings of women occur in specific contexts ~ Repercussions of femicide are experienced on a number of levels: family members, professionals, local community, society, intergenerational trauma ~ Research serves prevention ~ Untapped potential of comparative research: trends & patterns over space and time.

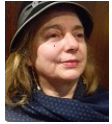
